PURPOSE

To ensure that the youth learn in-depth from the Seerah of Prophet ﷺ, that will help guide them to better understand and inform others about our Prophet ﷺ.



THEMES

Interested participants can choose any topic from the chronology of the life of the Prophet or any other focussed and detailed topic encompassing entire life with specific learnings. Some of the themes are provided below:

Timeframe of Seerah

- Birth to First Revelation
- Prophethood to Migration
- Migration to the Treaty of Hudaibiyah
- Treaty of Hudaibiyah to Conquest of Makkah
- Conquest of Makkah to Death

Some General Themes

- Tawheed and Guidance
- Manners and Personality Attributes
- Patience and perseverance
- Allah's help
- Mercy to mankind
- Companions of the Prophet ﷺ (Male and Female)



WHO CAN ENTER?

The conference is open to both females and males, and the speaker sessions will be in two groups:

- ✓ Group 1 – High School Students (Grade 10 to 12)
- ✓ Group 2- University Students (Year 1 to 4)

To be eligible to speak in this conference, the entrants should belong to one of the above two categories.

- Conference – Jan 02, 2021

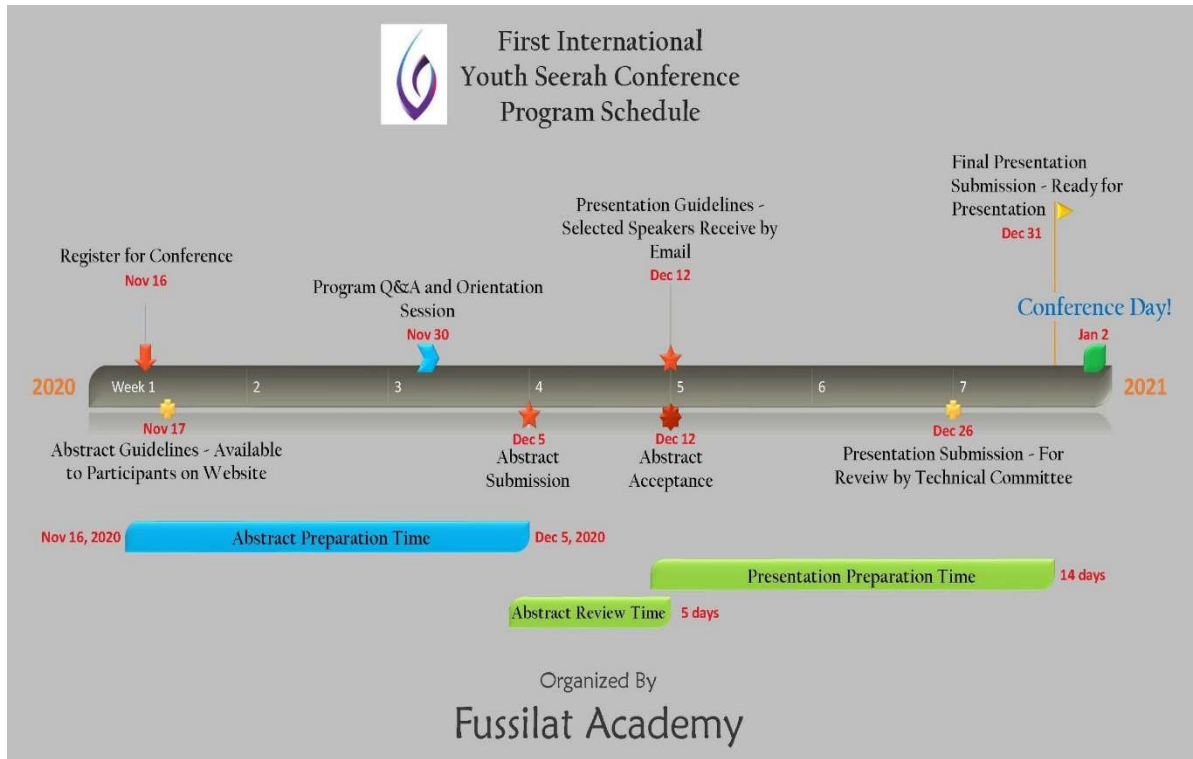

HOW TO ENTER

- Before the deadline (Dec 12, 2020), please submit your abstract to the email youthseerahconference@gmail.com or through our website www.fussilat.com
- All abstracts are collected and reviewed by the organizing team.
- The organizing technical team will review the abstracts for the contents to be presented at the conference.
- The selected speakers will be notified by email on or before Dec 15, -2020, and a presentation preparation guideline will be sent subsequently.

Abstract Submission Guidelines



ABSTRACT CRITERIA

- Speakers are encouraged to write abstracts on the topics they are passionate about. However, to ensure that the abstract has the potential for gaining acceptance, the topic must meet the following requirements:
 - The topic should be related to the Seerah of the Prophet and align to one of the provided themes or be closely related to it.
 - The topic should be one of our key focus that will create an impact on people
 - The information presented must come from authentic sources.
- Abstracts must include sufficient information for reviewers to evaluate the nature and significance of the topic
- Abstracts should be no more than 250 words, if you are submitting as email attachment it should be formatted in Microsoft Word, and single-spaced, using size 12 Times New Roman or Arial font.
- Abstracts should highlight the significant points of your topic and explain why the topic is important.
- Note that the selected speakers will be given 12-15 minutes to speak about the topic, so prepare the abstract accordingly.
