Purpose and Objectives

The Prophet Muhammad (SAW) is central to the life of every Muslim and is every Muslim's role model. Noting the prevalence of negative sentiments against the Prophet in certain parts of the world, it is our belief that bringing together people, especially youth, and encouraging them to research and present about the Prophet will help spread respect and true understanding of the Prophet (SAW). Key objectives of conference are:

- To encourage youth to read about Prophet ﷺ and provide a platform to share.
- To give them confidence to speak about Prophet ﷺ and clarify the misunderstandings.
- To instill characters of Prophet ﷺ in youth, help them understand more about his life and put into practice



Themes

Interested participants can choose any topic from chronology of life of Prophet or any other focussed and detailed topic encompassing entire life with specific learnings. Some of the themes are provided below:

- Darkness to Light – Birth to Revelation
- Patience and Perseverance – From revelation to migration
- Clear Triumph – Migration to Treaty of Hudaibiyah
- Ultimate Victory – Treaty of Hudaibiyah to Conquest of Makkah
- Completion of Blessings – Conquest of Makkah to Death
- Prophet in various roles (Leader, teacher and mentor, father, husband etc.)
- Role of women during Prophet's time
- Prophet's treatment towards animals, plants and environment.
- Prophets relationship with people of other faith



Eligibility to participate

We are seeking abstracts from interested participants. The conference is open to both boys and girls, and will be run in two tracks,

- Track 1 - High School Students (Grade 10 to 12)
- Track 2 - University Students (Year 1 to 4)
