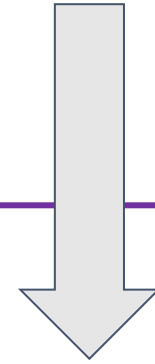

Locked down

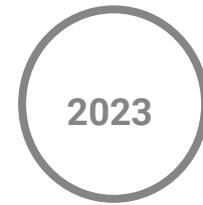
We were still being affected at a slower pace and had to remain in our homes for the most part. Many still couldn't travel and meet family.

Following all the difficulties from previous years and the ongoing financial crisis we are heading towards a mild recession.



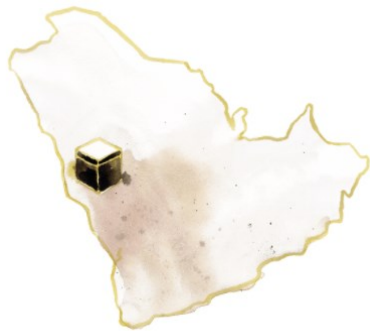

Events of Treaty:

1. 6th year after hijrat

Prophet (SAW), envisioned a dream of him doing tawaf around the Kaaba. Took his people and headed to Mecca



2. Stopped on the Plains of Hidaybiyyah

As they approached Mecca they got stopped. All the companions got tired from the delay and wanted to perform Umrah

3. Back-and-Forth

There was lots of conflict between the people of Mecca and Medina, as the conditions from the other side wounded unfair



4. Sign of the Treaty

After lots of discussion, Prophet (SAW) signed the "Treaty of Hidaybiyyah".

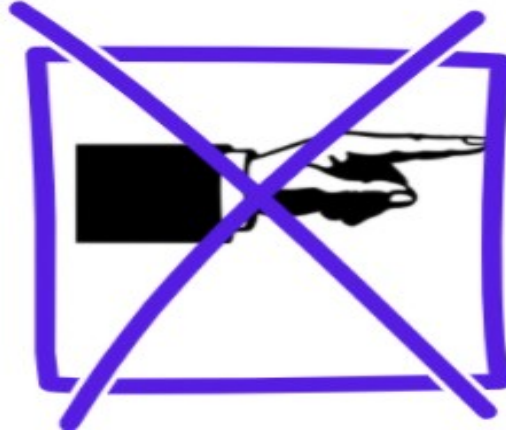
